Every Hobart Brothers mild steel and low alloy steel tubular wire sold in America – flux-cored and metal-cored (with the exception of our Megafil wires) – meets the Buy American requirement for projects funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). These tubular wires also meet the American Iron and Steel (AIS) requirement in section 436 of P.L. 113-76, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. That means that our filler metals are composed of steel melted in United States steel mills. Plus, each of our tubular wires meets exacting standards for quality and performance. You can be certain that they'll provide the right chemical and mechanical properties for your infrastructure application – every time.
